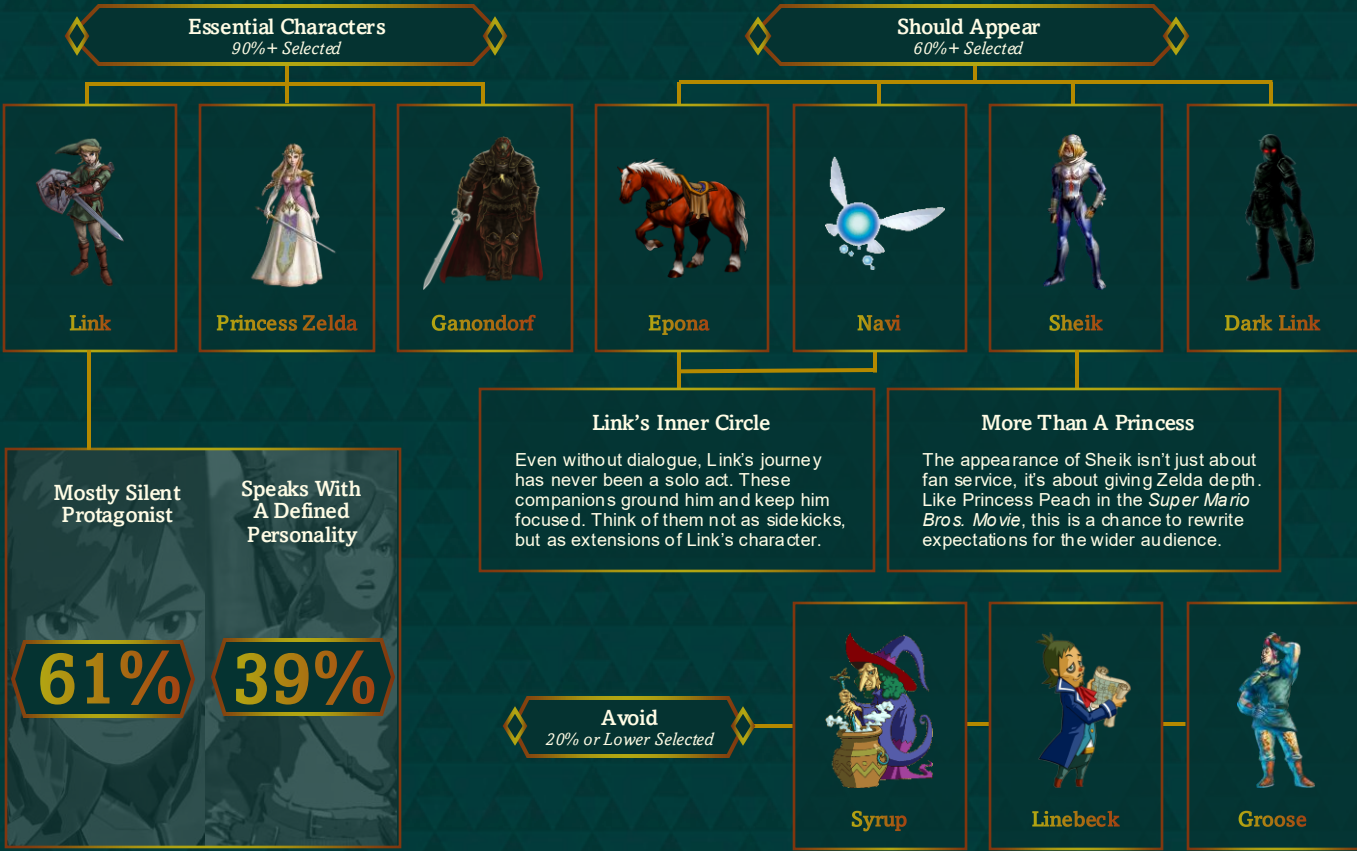

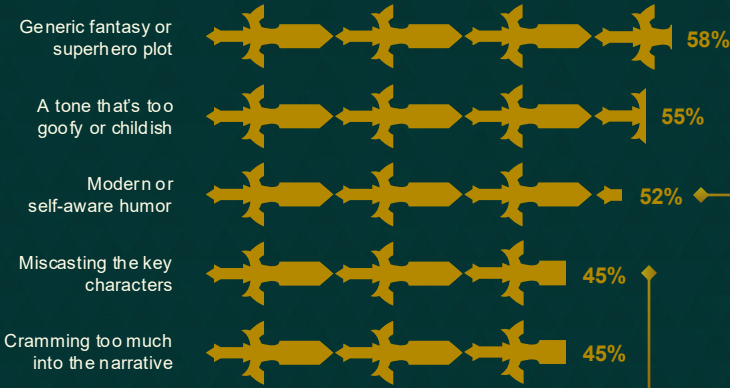

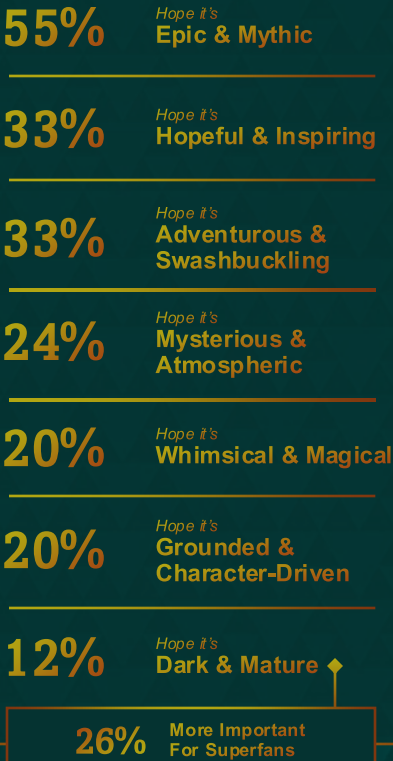
Tone is the Tightrope

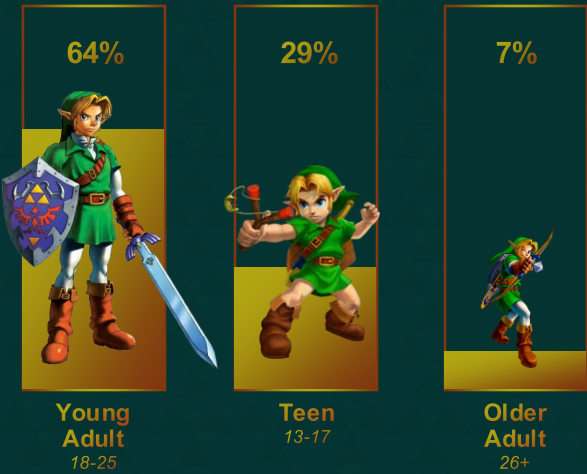
Preferred Movie Tone

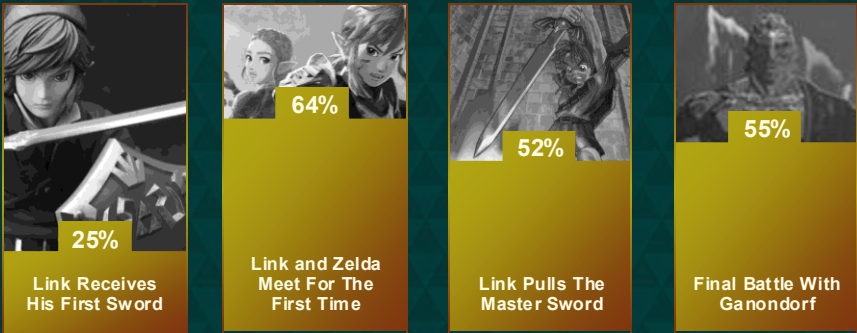
EPIC & HOPEFUL, WITH AN EDGE
